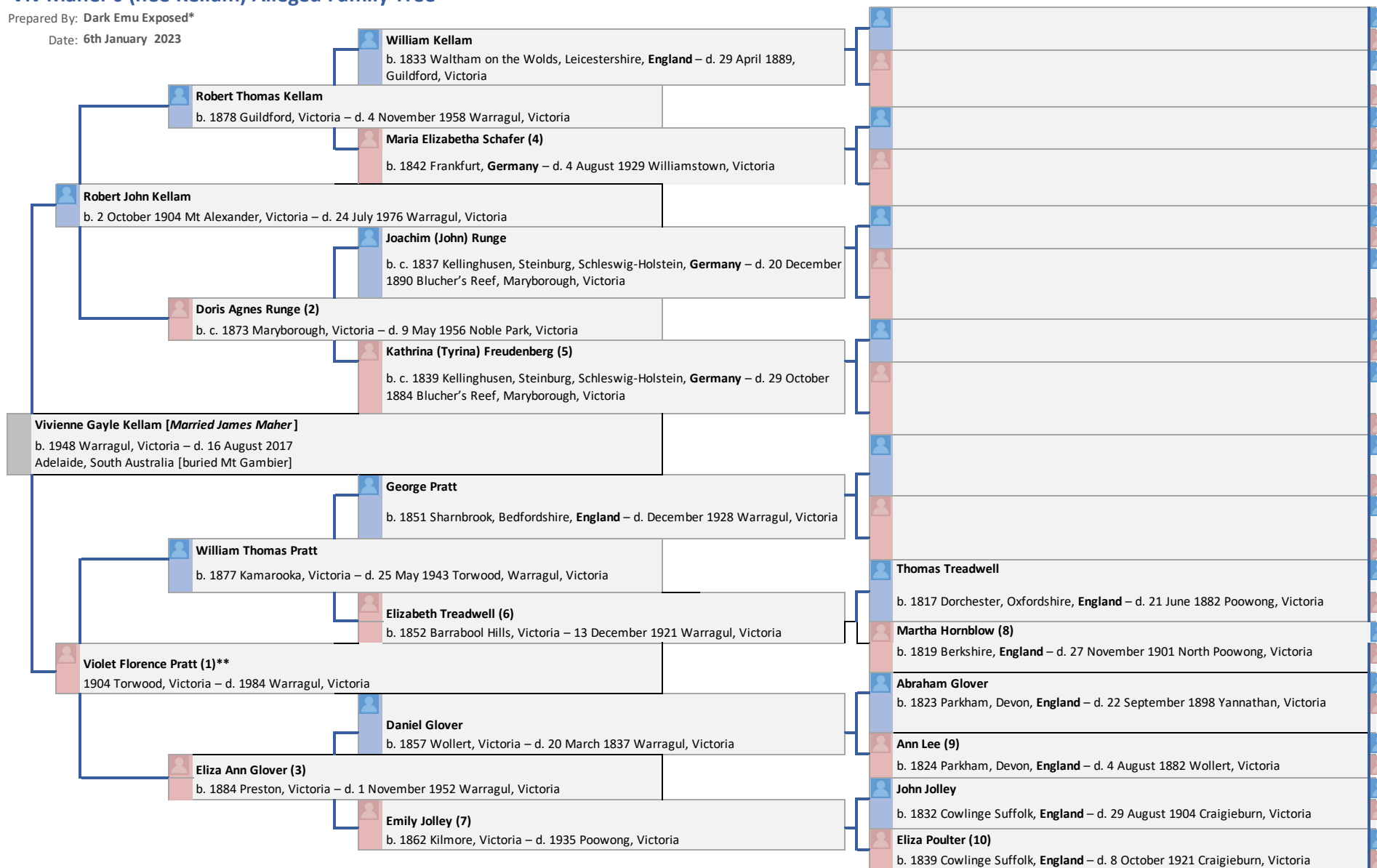


Viv Maher's (nee Kellam) Alleged Family Tree*
