





Some family trees on Ancestry have Henry Heywood as a convict arriving in Tasmania in 1829. I don't believe this is the correct person. They also have him being born in Croydon, Surry, England, as this is the only baptism record they can find with the correct names for him and parents. All researchers have overlooked the witness Josias Heywood, and none have him in their trees. Josias remained in Tasmania and was heavily involved in the Wesleyan Church. He died in 1886 at the age of 79. i.e born circa 1807. Most parish records for England are from the Church of England. The Wesleyan Church was classified as a Dissenter Church. Although, more dissenter records are coming online, most are not available at this time. It is also relevant that both Henry and Josias signed their names, showing that they were educated above most convicts at that time.


